

**PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE**

**MATERIAL TRANSFER AGREEMENT:  
For Requesting Research Material from NIA's Mutant Mouse Aging Colony**

This Material Transfer Agreement ("MTA") has been adopted for use by the National Institute on Aging (NIA) at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) specifically for transferring research material (**RESEARCH MATERIAL**) to academia and non-profits.

Definitions:

**DONOR:** Scientist and Scientist's organization contributing material(s) to the Mutant Mouse Aging Colony

**REPOSITORY:** Facility/Institution storing and shipping stocks for the National Institute on Aging, through its Contractor, Taconic Farms, contract N01-AG-4-0009.

**RECIPIENT:** Scientist and Scientist's organization requesting and receiving NIA's material(s)

In response to the **RECIPIENT'S** request for the following **RESEARCH MATERIAL:** (describe with specificity: strain name and NIA line #, etc.)

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(hereinafter referred to as **RESEARCH MATERIAL**), the **NIA** asks that the **RECIPIENT INSTITUTION** and the **RECIPIENT SCIENTIST** agree to the following before the **RECIPIENT** receives the **RESEARCH MATERIAL**.

This **RESEARCH MATERIAL** will be used by **RECIPIENT'S** investigator solely in connection with the following government-funded research project ("**RESEARCH PROJECT**") described with specificity as follows (include grant number, PI, and title):

1. The above **RESEARCH MATERIAL** is the property of the **DONOR** and is made available through the **REPOSITORY** (Taconic Farms) to the **RECIPIENT** as a service to the research community.
2. **THIS RESEARCH MATERIAL MAY NOT BE USED IN HUMAN SUBJECTS, INCLUDING FOR PURPOSES OF DIAGNOSTIC TESTING.** The **RESEARCH MATERIAL** will only be used for research purposes by **RECIPIENT'S** investigator in his/her laboratory, for the research project described below, under suitable containment conditions. This **RESEARCH MATERIAL** will not be used for screening, production or sale, for which a commercialization license may be required. The **RESEARCH MATERIAL** will not be used for any project funded in any part by any commercial entity. **RECIPIENT** agrees to comply with all

Federal rules and regulations applicable to the **RESEARCH PROJECT** and the handling of the **RESEARCH MATERIAL**.

3. The **RESEARCH MATERIAL** obtained from the **REPOSITORY** by the **RECIPIENT** will not be further distributed to others. **RECIPIENT**'s investigator agrees to retain control over this **RESEARCH MATERIAL** and agrees not to transfer the **RESEARCH MATERIAL** or any part thereof to other individuals not under her or his direct supervision. **RECIPIENT**'s investigator agrees they will not breed the mice described as the **RESEARCH MATERIAL**. The **RECIPIENT** shall refer any outside request for the **RESEARCH MATERIAL** to the **NIA**.
4. In all oral presentations or written publications concerning the **Research Project**, **RECIPIENT** will acknowledge **DONOR**'s contribution of this **RESEARCH MATERIAL** unless requested otherwise.
5. Any **RESEARCH MATERIAL** delivered pursuant to this Agreement is understood to be experimental in nature and may have hazardous properties. This **RESEARCH MATERIAL** is provided as a service to the research community. **THE DONOR AND REPOSITORY MAKE NO REPRESENTATIONS AND EXTEND NO WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND, EITHER EXPRESSED OR IMPLIED. THERE ARE NO EXPRESS OR IMPLIED WARRANTIES OR MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, OR THAT THE USE OF THE MATERIAL WILL NOT INFRINGE ANY PATENT, COPYRIGHT, TRADEMARK, OR OTHER PROPRIETARY RIGHTS.** Unless prohibited by law, **RECIPIENT** assumes all liability for claims for damages against it by third parties which may arise from the use, storage or disposal of the **RESEARCH MATERIAL**.
6. The **RECIPIENT** agrees to use the **RESEARCH MATERIAL** in compliance with all applicable statutes and regulations, including all applicable Federal statutes and Public health Service policies relating to the use and care of laboratory animals (see 7 U.S.C. 2131 et seq.). 7. **RECIPIENT** shall retain title to any patent or other intellectual property rights in inventions made by its employees in the course of the **RESEARCH PROJECT**. **RECIPIENT** agrees not to claim, infer, or imply endorsement by the Government of the United States of America (hereinafter referred to as "**Government**") of the **RESEARCH PROJECT**, the institution or personnel conducting the **RESEARCH PROJECT** or any resulting product(s). Unless prohibited by law from doing so, **Recipient** agrees to hold the **Government** harmless and to indemnify the **Government** for all liabilities, demands, damages, expenses and losses arising out of **RECIPIENT'S** use for any purpose of the **RESEARCH MATERIAL**.
8. The undersigned **RECIPIENT** and the **NIA** expressly certify and affirm that the contents of any statements made herein are truthful and accurate.

9. This **MTA** shall be construed in accordance with Federal law as applied by the Federal courts in the District of Columbia.
