

Due to changes in the newer Windows versions the CD will not run automatically when inserted in the computer and certain files will not open. Here are the fixes to this.

Insert disc. In older Windows version it may open automatically. In Windows 7, it will not. Click the start button, then computer, and look for the drive that lists the CD (usually under heading “Devices with Removable Storage”). Double click on that drive and the directory of files will open. Find the first “Start” file, dated 4/22/2003, file type: Application. Double click that and the CD will start.

In the Table of Contents each area will run when clicked on. However, for Test Administration Tools and Resource Center, for certain parts of them, when you get inside them the individual files will not open due to Adobe issues. These files can be opened by going back to the directory of files for the disc. They are all in the pdf subdirectory, with the numbers corresponding to the numbers of the reference articles and the scoring sheet and wall chart also listed. Double click on those and you can see the files.
